This event will be run on two contest areas and is open to all BJC, BJA & AJA members / clubs. A valid and up to date licence must be produced on the day – No Licence = no contest & no refund.

- Age categories for 5 7 Year olds and 8 & 9 Year olds will be matched into pools of four by closest weight. Please note that the 5 7 Year old age group is for BJC members only.
- Age categories for 10 12 & 13 15 Year olds and Seniors will be competing in set weight categories where there will be one Gold, one Silver and two Bronze medals available. Where necessary, this will be done in pools to knockout format or ju st a pool format where numbers permit.
- Senior Male categories will be fought in separate Kyu & Dan grade categories and Senior Female categories will be fought in separate Kyu and Dan grade categories if numbers permit.
- All contests will be fought using the latest BJC Contest rules, a copy of which can be found on the BJC website: <u>http://www.britishjudocouncil.org/technical-notices.php.</u> Please note the restricted techniques for Primary & Junior categories.
- Where there are insufficient numbers to make a complete category, we reserve the right to merge categories where it is deemed safe to do so.
- There will be no penalty for moving up OR down weight categories, please be aware that each competitor will only be allowed ONE weigh in.
- Zoris MUST be worn to the contest area, any competitor arriving at the contest area not wearing zoris or flip flops (not crocs) will be asked to change their footwear accordingly.
- By entering this competition, coaches and parents agree to allow videos and photographs to be taken.
- The referee's decision will be final.
- Water may be brought to the side of the mat if it is in a sealed drinks bottle.
- Judogi must be White and comply with BJC Regulations. Reversible Judogi will NOT be accepted. No White Judogi = no contest & no refund. This also includes plain white high neck t-shirts for girls (club logo permitted).
- NO COACHING WILL BE ALLOWED FROM THE SIDE OF THE MAT OR FROM THE CROWD anyone caught coaching from the side of the mat risks the competitor being disqualified from that contest.
